



**Educator Preparation for Achievement in Reading
(E-Prep)
Professional Learning Program**

Credit Options

Professional learning credit may be earned for successful completion of the Educator Preparation for Achievement in Reading (E-Prep) Professional Learning Program. All E-Prep Program credit is awarded through the Center for Quality Teaching and Learning (CQTL) and the College of Education (COE) at Columbus State University (CSU) in Columbus, Georgia. Two credit options are available to certified educators completing the E-Prep Program with the approval of a cooperating school system and under the direction of a certified E-Prep Program Instructor.

OPTION 1: Academic Credit – Nine (9) academic credit hours qualifies a candidate for a Reading Endorsement awarded through the Georgia Professional Standards Commission

OPTION 2: Professional Learning Credit – 100+ contact hours qualifies a participant for 10 Professional Learning Units (10 PLUs) through the CSU Center for Quality Teaching and Learning
